Some Records of Mayflies (Ephemeroptera) from Northern Norway. — While going through the rich material of *Ephemeroptera* at the Entomological Museum of the University of Helsinki, there came in my hands some samples preserved in spirits, which had been collected in Northern Norway. From these localities, as far as I know, no notices about mayflies have been published earlier.¹ Among them, according to my knowledge, are a couple of species, new to the fauna of Norway, for which reason these records are worthy to be published in the form of the following list.

Siphonurus Zetterstedti BGTN. — Syd-Varanger Pykeia (= Bugnäs) (U. SAALAS) 18. VIII 1905, imagines and larvae.

Siphurella Linnaeana ETN. — Vadsö (U. SAALAS) 17—20. VIII. 1905, imagines and larvae.

Parametetus chelifer BGTN. — Vadsö and Pykeia (U. SAALAS) 17—20. VIII. 1905, larvae.

Ameletus inopinatus ETN. — Finmarken (Ruija) Puolmak (U. SAALAS) 15. VIII. 1905, 5 nymphs.

Ameletus alpinus BGTN. — Maitokoski (E. KANERVO and W. M. LINNANIEMI) 1. VII. 1928, 5 ♂ imagines. New to Norway.

Baëtis subalpinus BGTN. — Syd-Varanger Pykeia (U. SAALAS) 18. VIII. 1905, imagines ♂, ♀. New to Norway.

Baëtis Wallengreni BGTN. — Maitokoski (E. KANERVO) 1. VII. 1928, 1 ♂ imago.

Acentrella lapponica BGTN. — Syd-Varanger Pykeia (U. SAALAS) 18. VIII 1905, 2 ♂ imagines.
